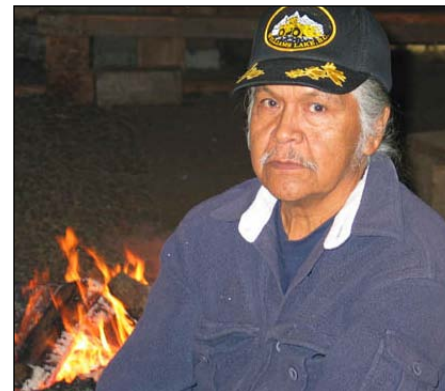

SYNOPSIS *From Bella Coola to Berlin* is a documentary about nine First Nations men from Canada who took part in the German Volkerschau, or people shows, that were a popular form of entertainment in Europe in the late 19th and early 20th centuries. The documentary blends archival photographs, rare historic footage, dramatic vignettes and interviews with German scholars and Nuxalk Elders as it reconstructs the dancers' experience in Germany more than 125 years ago.
